Tour de Houston Presented by Apache Corporation

Sunday, April 7, 2024

- The purpose of the Tour de Houston Presented by Apache Corporation is to promote physical fitness and alternate transportation.
- Funds raised will benefit the City's reforestation program, RE-Plant Houston, managed by the Houston Parks and Recreation Department through the Houston Parks Board.
- On Sunday, April 7, 2024, Mayor John Whitmire and Apache Corporation, will kick-off the "Tour de Houston Presented by Apache Corporation" at 7:30 a.m. for the 60-mile route, 7:45 a.m. for the 40-mile route and 8:00 a.m. for the 20-mile route (approximate miles).
- Ride begins and ends on Avenida de las Americas at Discovery Green.
- The Tour de Houston is an open route. The Houston Police Department, in coordination with other security entities, will manage traffic control at most intersections to offer a safe and enjoyable rider experience.
- Generously stocked rest stops with healthy snacks, water, maintenance support and port-a-cans will be available for riders every 10-15 miles along the route.

 - Sunday, April 7 from 6:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. at Discovery Green
- **PARTICIPANT PARKING:**
 - Day-of complimentary parking for ride participants is available at Tundra Garage, with entrances off La Branch Street (available on a first-come first-served basis).
 - If you have a mounted bike rack exceeding the 7' maximum for garages, there are many paid surface lots in the surrounding area with daily costs ranging from \$2-\$25.
